


Main Facts: the 2023 March is June 3. The March goes from 10 AM-12 PM.

Here is a working model of an organizational chart for us to tweak. See

Bishop would like **all workers** to park at Harbor Park (near the train station) and arrive at Ruffner Middle School at **8:30 AM** so we can leave Ruffner at 10 sharp. All marchers should also park harbor Park and arrive at Ruffner no later than 9 AM.

The March will arrive at City Hall about **10:30** for a 90 minute program that **ends at noon**. Clean-up until 12:30. Port-a-potties arrive on May 27 Harbor Park Parking near the train station.

website and fill out a form that will be emailed to the Team Coordinator for that team.

Sound Systems Coordinator (Big Job!): Aaron Cook Serves under Michelle Littman. Aaron will need assistants

Insures that we have the songs for the March on either **mp3 devices** (like this one) or phones to play through 5-10 portable sound systems loud enough for about 100 people marching behind them.

- Gather **5 to 10 portable sound systems** to use from the back of a vehicle. People can use a form on the website to loan us one.
- Aquire enough mp3 players and attachment cords for all the sound trucks.
- Train the Music DJ's in April to play the music through the portable sound system.
- This job needs a lot of attention!
- There usually are some technical issues connecting the phone to the portable amp. Last time, they lacked he right cords, etc.
- Ideally, these sound systems **need to be tested BEFORE the day of the march**. You may be able to do training and testing via Zoom to help the sound techs test their systems.
- Bring extra portable sound system in case one goes down.
- Call the Music DJ's in March and April and May to confirm their participation.
- **Have backups!** Create a playlist on Spotify or Youtube of the same songs in case the Mp3 player does not work.

Sound Truck Drivers Coordinator: Chris Brady

- Serve under Aaron Cook and Michelle Littman
- Oversee the sound trucks prep at Ruffner Middle School

- The list of drivers should be on the MFJ Spreadsheet
- Call drivers on in April and May to confirm their participation.
- Help **MFJ Ushers** line up behind a truck as they leave the Ruffner parking lot.
- Last minute driver cancellations can happen. Have 1-2 backup trucks.

Music Sheets Coordinator: Printed and Digital Serves Under Pastor Ray Boetcher: 757) 285-2222 theriverroom@minister.com

Aaron Cook sends words to march songs to Ray who have them printed at GO Church by **Pastor Chris Cunningham. Use QR code** on the sheets (Bob will produce) so they or others can use their phones to view the words.

Ray or Aaron creates a PDF that Bob Fox will email to all registered marchers to view on their phones while they march. Bob will ask them if they plan to use the PDF so we can print fewer copies.

Assure that we have enough printed song sheets for **MFJ Ushers to** pass them out at Ruffner prior to 10 AM. Better to have more than needed.

• Direct people parking at Harbor Park to walk to Ruffner or near City Hall if they choose. Print some small maps to give directions

March and Worship Usher Coordinator: Pastor Clinton and Coach McDowell?

Help people stay safe on the march, know where the port-a-potties are, alert leaders to problems, medical needs, etc. Have all Ushers call Coach/Pastor Clinton if needed.

- Document the march and city Hall events well and share the media with everyone via the team DropBox which Bob Fox administers.
- Decide among themselves who will cover what part of the march so all segments are documented.

First Aid Team: Who?

Assist marchers with minor injuries with a **First Aid Kit** or help them with medical emergencies by calling 911 and staying with them.

Publicity Coordinator: Roberta Perry

 Coordinate and initiate all forms of publicity: social media, radio, TV, billboard, etc. Volunteers to help can sign up on the website and Roberta will be notified by email automatically. Roberta has confirmed Pastors Coordinators: Michelle Littman, Darrell Wentworth and Miguel Dabul. They will contact pastors to encourage them to bring their church to the March.

MFJ Banner Coordinator: Bishop Cleveland & Assistants

- Distribute the four 8 x 3 MFJ banners to be carried behind the four leading sound trucks. Get four people to carry the 10 x 4 MFJ banner at the front of the parade.
- Have people hold the banners at City Hall if possible.
- Collect and **carefully** fold all banners after the event and get them back to Bob Fox. All four small banners go in one box.
